

Spring 2022 Semester Covid Policy

Until further changes are made easing Covid restrictions in NV, our policies for the Spring 2022 classes at Seedling are as follows. Please read carefully and sign this document, returning it with your child the next time they come to class. You can also send a pic of this signed document via email or SLACK DM

Admittance to the Facility

All individuals entering the studio are required to wear cloth face covering and be able to answer “no” to having any symptoms related to Covid infections posted at the front door.

Face Coverings

Those who are performing or teaching onstage by themselves or at opposite ends of our stage from others will be allowed to do so without face coverings, provided the class is appropriately distanced from the stage. Aside from that, **face coverings are required** by everyone at all times. Vocal performance classes will continue to operate on a solo performance format without group numbers and face coverings will be worn during vocalizing exercises while students remain in their **assigned distanced seating**. Again, if restrictions ease in the coming months, we will adjust our policies accordingly. Showcase Vocal Performance may work on group numbers with the proper distancing precautions

Sanitizing

High traffic and high touch areas are sanitized regularly. Hand sanitizer is provided in all rooms and students are advised to visit the bathroom to wash hands before class.

Spacing in class & Student Responsibility

Student seating will be spaced apart to maintain at least 3 ft of distance and students will be asked to remain in their seats when not participating onstage or in other theater activities. Respecting the personal space of others and keeping a “hands-to-ourselves” policy are points students will need to understand and adopt in order to continue attending Seedling classes.

It is vital that you understand that **students who attend classes at Seedling at this time must be able to govern themselves** in these basic safe-health practices. If you feel your child lacks the self-discipline to respect the personal space others because of age, maturity, or some other factor, please consider waiting until this public health crisis subsides to enroll him/her in a class with us.

Procedure for Exposures

Any Seedling class that has been exposed to a student infected by the Covid-19 virus OR who tests positive for Covid-19 infection within 3 days following attendance will go to online instruction-only for the following week of classes. It is recommended that your child be tested 3-5 days after exposure and quarantine if needed.

No refunds of tuition will be given for those breaks in live classes in the semester.
